the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.*

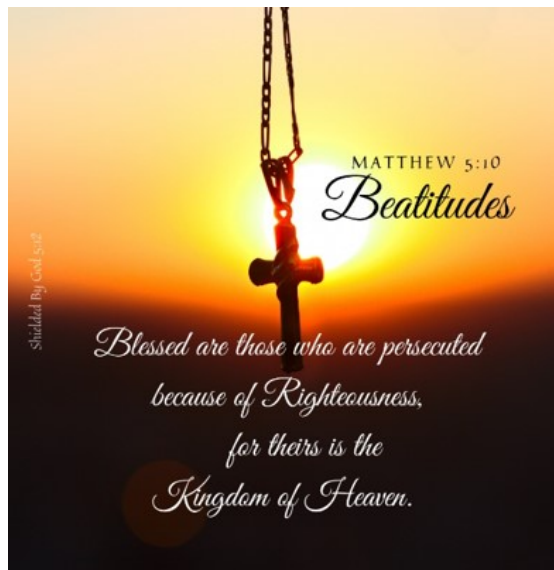


“Beatitudes, Part III ”

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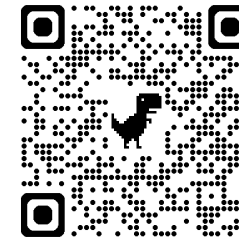
